# Walk down memory Lane - Part 4

Part four will use the last color set and some blue for the blanket. And when we think of blue colors, for me, things like water, sea, and oceans are the first thing that comes to mind. Luckily, I have created the Soul of the Sea shawl and blanket patterns. These patterns hold a lovely wave section, giving the blanket even more stretch. The next part I will add is one I have added several times. You can find the same wave pattern in the Spice Market blanket, the Soul of the Sea shawl pattern, and the Soul of the Sea blanket. Although I don't think those are all the same, all three have a different amount of stitches and tension, and in the end, the version in the Soul of the Sea blanket seemed the right one to pick. So, let's start by using that one as the next pattern part.

#### Pattern used:

The Soul of the Sea blanket pattern is required for the fourth Part of the walk down memory lane blanket. All general information like photos, special notes, and stitches used can be found in the pattern.

## Yarn and hook:

In all parts, colors A and B are used. In part 4, we will use the Blue Color Set. So take Color C-G from the blue color set for this Part. Tineke's Masterpiece version will use all three colors in all parts. For both versions, crochet hook size 4.0mm is used.

## Tineke's masterpiece color use:

As Tineke only used three colors to create the same project, here use of colors was divided into different ways. Therefore, behind each instruction, you will find a color between (). This indicates the use of the color Tineke used.

### Instructions:

We first start with two individual Rounds to increase some stitches before we use the Soul of the Sea blanket pattern. Take Color A and crochet hook size 4.0mm.

Take Color A and attach it to any ch2-crn. Ch1 (doesn't count as st), (2sc-ch2-2sc in ch2-crn, 1sc in next 69 sts, 2sc in next st, 1sc in next 68 sts) 4 times. Ss in top of first st to connect. Fasten off Color A. [4 sides of 143sc/ch2-crn] (C)

Now, Take Color C and attach it to any ch2-crn. Ch1 (doesn't count as st), (1sc-ch2-1sc in ch2-crn, 1sc in each st of side till next ch2-sp) 4 times. Ss in top of first st to connect. Ss to next ch2-crn. [4 sides of 145sc/ch2-crn] (B)

We will now start with the Soul of the Sea blanket pattern at Round 8.

**R8:** With Color C, crochet Round 8, but change the number of repeats in the Round from twice to 23 times. At the end of Round 8, fasten off Color C. [4 sides of 75sc/24 times a ch6-sp and 4 times and a ch2-crn] **(B)** 

**R9:** With Color D, crochet Round 9, but change the number of repeats in the Round from twice to 23 times. [4 sides of 29sc/24 times a 9sc-bow and 4 times and a ch2-crn] **(B)** 

**R10:** With Color D, crochet Round 10, but change the number of repeats in the Round from 3 to 24 times. At the end of Round 10, fasten off Color D. [4 sides of 6dc/24 times a 3sc-gr/25 times a 6ch-sp and 4 times and a ch2-crn] **(B)** 

**R11:** With Color E, crochet Round 11 but change the number of repeats in the Round from twice to 24 times. [4 sides of 30sc/25 times a 9sc-bow and 4 times and a ch2-crn] **(B)** 

**R12:** With Color E, crochet Round 12, but change the number of repeats in the Round from 3 to 25 times. At the end of Round 12, fasten off Color E. [4 sides of 6dc/25 times a 3sc-gr/26 times a 6ch-sp and 4 times and a ch2-crn] **(B)** 

**R13:** With Color F, crochet Round 13, but change the number of repeats in the Round from twice to 25 times. [4 sides of 31sc/26 times a 9sc-bow and 4 times and a ch2-crn] **(B)** 

**R14:** With Color F, crochet Round 14, but change the number of repeats in the Round from 5 to 26 times. At the end of Round 14, fasten off Color F. [4 sides of 6tr/26 times a 3sc-gr/27 times a 4ch-sp and 4 times and a ch2-crn](B)

R15: With Color G [4 sides of 167sc/ 4 times a ch2-crn] (B)

R16: With Color G crochet Round 16. Fasten off Color G. [4 sides of 169DC and 4 times a CH2-crn] (C)

Now crochet one last individual Round to create a good total of stitches for the next Part.

Take Color B and attach it to any ch2-crn. Ch4 (first hdc + ch2), 1hdc in same ch2-crn, 1bphdc around each st of side till next ch2-crn. (1hdc-ch2-1hdc in next ch2-crn, 1bphdc around each st of side till next ch2-crn) 3 times. Ss in top of the second ch to connect. Fasten off Color B. [4 sides of 2hdc/169bphdc and 4 times a ch2-crn] (C)

So far, Part 4 of the walk down memory lane blanket. We added some sea to the pattern and will proceed to another pattern in the next Part. In the next Part, we will start working on more minor things. Weave in ends.
